#### **Roadmap for Managing Our Forest Land**

Managing our 40-acre parcel of forest land has been a topic of discussion at recent membership meetings. Overgrowth on that land is a fire risk, potentially threatening the homes in our community. In early 2022 Tim Peterson asked Beth Coira to take the lead in planning a course of action to better manage this land.

Beth worked with the Washington State Department of Natural Resources to assess the health of our forest, and this last spring coordinated a walkthrough with two DNR reps and five of our community members. The overall results of the walkthrough were positive, but some areas for improvement were noted. Beth has created a draft roadmap for addressing both the health of the forest and better utilizing it for recreational purposes; a copy of the draft is enclosed with this mailing. This roadmap will be discussed at the Fall membership meeting.

#### **Tree Height**


The impact of tree and building heights on the views of community members was discussed at the Spring meeting. This discussion will continue to see how other Home Owners Associations manage this, and if any limits could or should be placed on new plantings.

#### **Rule Reminders**

As we close out a beautiful summer, please consider the rules governing our common areas. We've often heard concerns about some of the rules not being followed:

- All dogs in the common areas must be leashed unless actively fetching or swimming under control of the owner. Dogs are not permitted in the swim area.
- Glass bottles are not permitted on the beach
- Excessive or unreasonable noise levels, especially past 10 pm
- Check the latest Burn Bans Call before you burn: (509) 684-2555
- Leave no trace Please pickup after yourself and your family/guests
- Beach trash cans are for beach garbage only, not household garbage
- When table umbrellas are not in use, close them to prevent damage
