Key items on the agenda are:

- Dock Maintenance: Maintenance of our docks is a continuing effort.
 Work on docks 1 and 2 was completed this year, and dock 3 will be tackled next. Volunteers will be needed!
- Forest Management: A system of trails was completed this past spring, opening up recreational access to our 40 acres of forest land.
- Damage to Boat Launch Ramp: On Monday August 7th a downpour washed out part of our boat launch ramp. Extent of the damage and remedial efforts will be discussed at the fall meeting.

Loon Lake Property Owners Association

The Loon Lake Property Owners Association provides a number of services to help protect the quality of our lake. Two of their current efforts may be of direct interest to SAE members:

- Loon Lake Control Structure and Dam This dam controls the water level of the lake, and has deficiencies in need of attention.
 It is unclear at present just who is responsible for correcting these deficiencies, but it could affect lot owners around the lake.
- Invasive Aquatic Plants & Treatment 2023 treatments to control
 milfoil and curly-leaf pondweed have been completed for this
 year, but this is a multi-year effort. The LLPOA website has a great
 description of the problem and how it's being addressed.


Rule Reminders

As we close out a beautiful summer, please consider the rules governing our common areas. We've often heard concerns about some of the rules not being followed:

- All dogs in the common areas must be leashed unless actively fetching or swimming under control of the owner. Dogs are not permitted in the swim area.
- Glass bottles are not permitted on the beach
- Avoid excessive or unreasonable noise levels, especially past 10 pm
- Check the latest Burn Bans Call before you burn: (509) 684-2555
- Leave no trace Please pickup after yourself and your family/guests
- Beach trash cans are for beach garbage only, not household garbage
- When table umbrellas are not in use, close them to prevent damage
