- Beach trash cans are for beach garbage only (not household) when full, please take your trash home with you.
- Speeding: Our posted speed limit of 15 mph helps to ensure the safety of all neighbors traversing the road, whether by car, golf cart, or on foot. Please ask family and guests to observe and respect our desire for a pedestrian friendly community.

• Vandalization: Damage to SAE communal property costs us all as association members. Please keep an eye out and directly address or report any concerning activity.
